Safety and Operating Instructions

To ensure safe and proper operation of this electric treatment table, please read the following instructions carefully and retain this manual for future reference.

- **Proper Setup and Grounding:**
 - This electric treatment table requires a three-wire power cable and must be connected to a grounded three-prong power outlet. This ensures proper grounding, prevents accidental electric shock, and supports normal operation.
- **Avoid Water Exposure:**
 - All plugs, buttons, and connecting cables must not come into contact with water or any other liquids during use.
- **Inspect for Damage:**
 - Immediately discontinue use of the table if any plugs, buttons, or connecting cables are damaged.
- **Usage Frequency:**
 - The electric push rod of the treatment table should only be operated for up to 6 minutes per hour.
- **Professional Repairs Only:**
 - Repairs and maintenance must be conducted exclusively by trained and qualified professionals.

Precautions

1. Health Restrictions:

- This product should not be used by individuals with osteoporosis or heart conditions.
- Pregnant individuals should avoid using this product.
- Those with physical injuries or skin conditions are advised not to use this product.

2. Use by Minors and Individuals with Impaired Awareness:

3. Inspection Before Use:

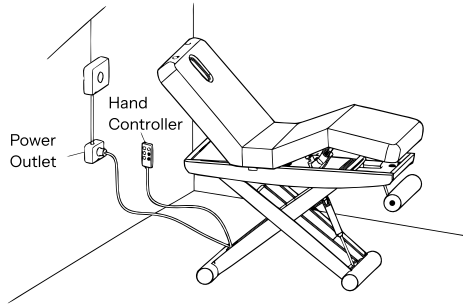
- Inspect the power cord and plug for damage before each use. If damage is found, they must be replaced by a qualified operator or authorized service provider.

4. Voltage Compliance:

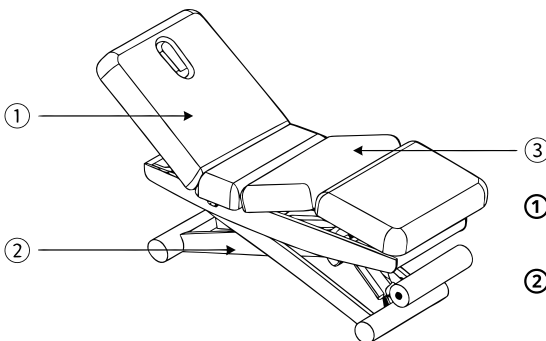
- Confirm that the product is connected to the correct voltage as specified. Incorrect voltage can result in product damage.

Installation

1. Place the product in the desired location according to the overall room layout, lighting, and operation conditions of the salon, spa, or treatment room. Keep the unit in a clean, dry, and cool environment.
2. Open the packaging and check that the product is intact. Confirm that all included accessories and spare parts are complete. Contact the distributor if anything is missing or damaged.
3. Position the product on a firm, flat, and stable surface. Make sure the unit is placed securely before use. If the product rocks or does not sit evenly, adjust its placement until it is stable.
4. Connect the power plug to the proper power supply as shown in the reference image.
5. Disconnect the plug from the main power supply before moving or servicing the product.

① Angle adjustment of the backrest

② Lifting adjustment

③ Adjustment angle of footrest

5. Electrical Safety:

- Do not handle the power plug with wet hands to prevent electric shock.
- Ensure the product is properly installed before powering it on or operating it.

6. Securing the Power Cord:

- Secure the power cord to prevent tripping, pulling, or damage.

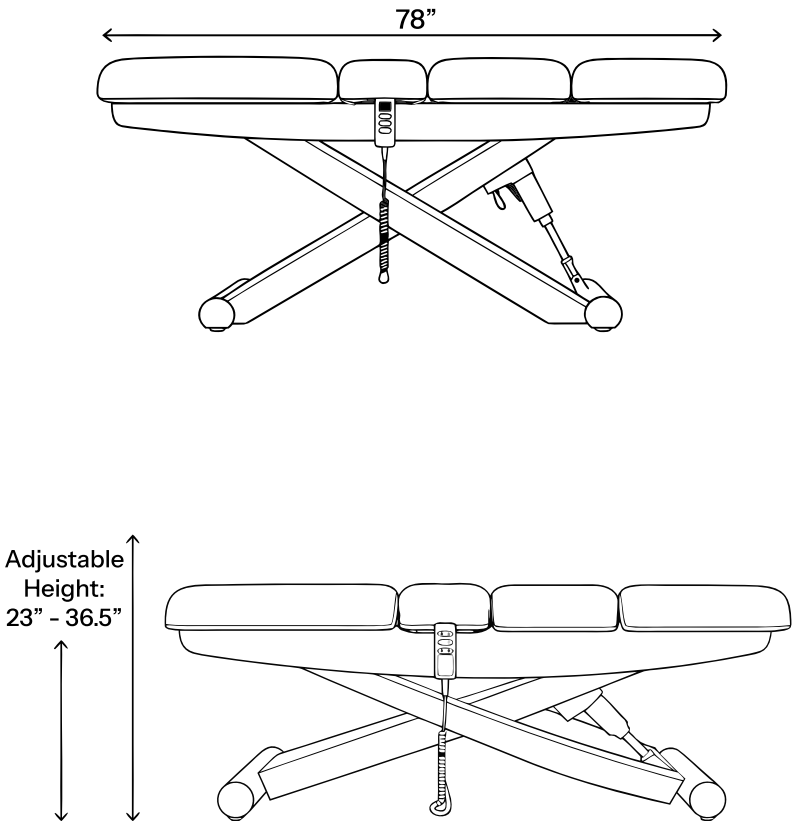
7. Cleaning:

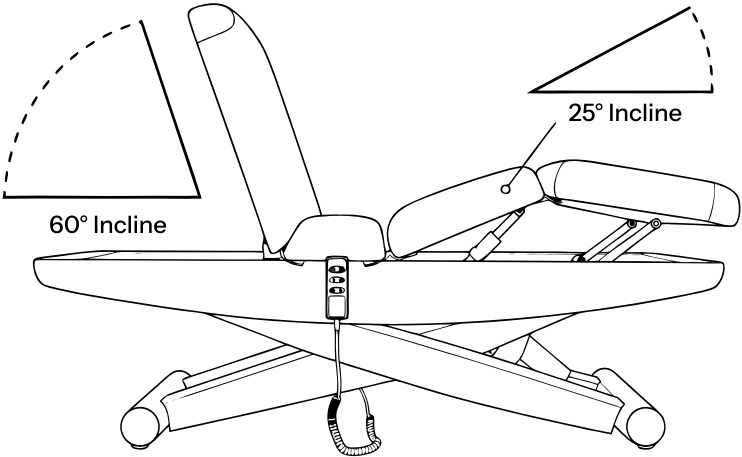
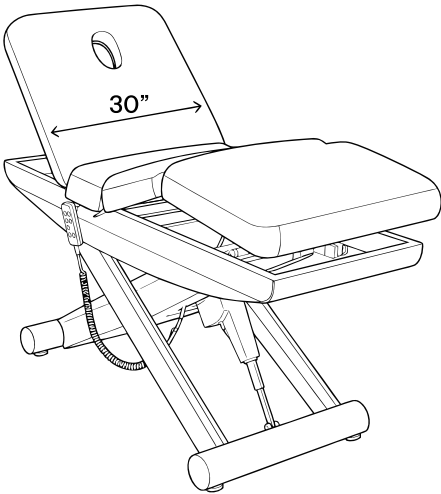
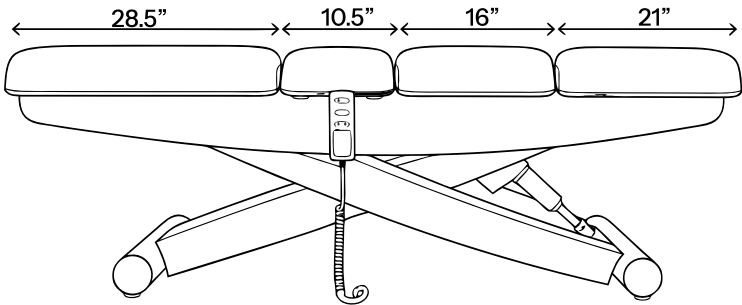
- Clean the product's surface with a soft towel dampened with neutral detergent.

8. Unplugging When Not in Use:

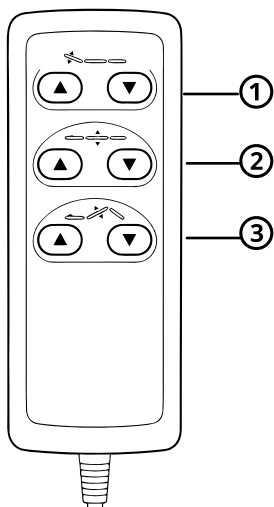
- Always unplug the product when it is not in use.

Remote Control Instructions



① Adjust the Backrest Angle

Press and hold the Up Arrow button to increase the backrest angle. Press and hold the Down Arrow button to decrease the backrest angle.

② Raise or Lower the Bed

Press and hold the Up Arrow button to raise the bed. Press and hold the Down Arrow button to lower the bed.

③ Adjust the Seat Cushion Angle

Press and hold the Up Arrow button to increase the seat cushion angle.

Press and hold the Down Arrow button to decrease the seat cushion angle.

LED Remote Instructions



① On

② Off

③ Color Wheel

④ Increase Brightness/Dimmer

⑤ Adjust Light Cycle Speed

⑥ White Mode & Light Sequence Setup

If the remote stops working, replace the batteries with two AAA batteries.

Maintenance

- When cleaning and sanitizing, do not use bleach, Barricade, or other harsh chemicals. Using harsh chemicals can damage the upholstery.
- For best results, we recommend cleaning with **SkinAct All-In-One Upholstery & Disinfecting Multi-Purpose Cleaner** (SKU24261).
- Clean and sanitize the upholstery after each treatment.
- Every six months, visually inspect all visible parts of the unit. If there are any abnormal noises or vibrations during operation, call Spa & Equipment/SkinAct at 1-800-418-0830.

Troubleshooting

Motor Does Not Operate Properly

Solution: Check that the hand controller or foot controller is securely connected and responding correctly. If the controller does not respond, discontinue use and contact the supplier or service center for inspection.

Control Box or Motor Malfunction

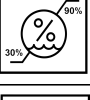
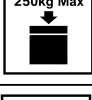
Solution: If the motor fails to operate after confirming the controller connection and power supply, stop using the product. Contact SkinAct/Spa & Equipment for troubleshooting or replacement parts.

Abnormal Noise During Operation

Solution: Apply lubricating oil to rotating or moving parts such as hinges, lift areas, or footrest joints. If the noise continues after lubrication, stop using the product and contact SkinAct/Spa & Equipment.

Power Display or Control Box Indicator Does Not Light Up

Solution: If the power display or control box indicator does not light up during normal use, the control box may need to be inspected or replaced. Contact SkinAct/Spa & Equipment for further assistance.
